RESOLUTION OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA

A Resolution Expressing Assembly Support for the Juneau Coordinated Transportation Coalition Plan.

WHEREAS, the Federal government encourages coordination in transportation services at all levels of government to make better use of Federal funds and improve service; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration established the United We Ride initiative in December, 2003, to improve the coordination of human service transportation in America; and

WHEREAS, Capital Transit and Care-a-Van services meet a high percentage of the transportation needs of elderly persons and persons with disabilities within the community; and

WHEREAS, to remain eligible for Federal funding for transportation services, providers need to participate in a Coordinated Transportation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the goals of the Juneau Coordinated Transportation Coalition are:

- Goal 1: To maximize transportation resources within the City and Borough to meet the specific needs of all riders;
- Goal 2: To ensure providers can participate to a level that complements their agency's services;
- Goal 3: To leverage funding opportunities that maximize transportation resource opportunities within the community; and
- Goal 4: To increase awareness and support of transportation services to all community sectors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CITY AND BOROUGH OF JUNEAU, ALASKA:

Section 1. That the Assembly of the City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska, supports the goals of the Juneau Coordinated Transportation Coalition Plan.

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
