Filing period to run for Juneau Assembly & School Board starts Friday

Anyone interested in running for Assembly or School Board in the October 3 municipal election must file two items with the City and Borough of Juneau City Clerk's office to be a certified candidate – a Nominating Petition signed by at least 25 registered voters and a signed copy of the Alaska Public Offices Commission's Public Official Financial Disclosure statement.

The filing period opens Friday, August 4 at 8:00 a.m. and closes Monday, August 14 at 4:30 p.m.

These seats are open and will be decided during the October 3 election:

- Areawide Assembly member – 3 year term
- District 1 Assembly member – 3 year term
- District 2 Assembly member – 3 year term
- Two School Board Members – 3 year terms

Nominating Petitions are available in the City Clerk's office in City Hall and [online](#). To file an Alaska Public Offices Commission's Public Official Financial Disclosure statement, you will need a [myAlaska](#) account.

Candidates for office must be qualified voters of the City and Borough of Juneau, which means you are:

- Qualified to vote in State elections;
- A resident of the municipality for at least 30 days immediately preceding the election;
- Registered to vote in state elections at a residence address within the municipality at least 30 days before the municipal election at which the person seeks to vote; and
- Not disqualified under Article V of the Alaska Constitution.

In addition, candidates for Assembly must be a resident of CBJ for at least one year immediately preceding election to office. Candidates for Assembly District 1 and District 2 seats must reside in the district from which elected or appointed at the time of the Assembly member's election or appointment
