Capital Transit resumes service and Ride Free Zone downtown

The City and Borough of Juneau's public bus system has resumed service into Downtown Juneau. Capital Transit had to take about a year hiatus from driving through downtown due to construction at the Alaska State Capitol and on South Franklin Street.

Riders can once again access bus service on Franklin Street, Fourth Street and Main Street. This route is also Capital Transit's Ride Free Zone (see the Downtown Ride Free Zone map on the next page).

"This is a free option for locals and tourists who may experience mobility issues or are interested in getting to the Capitol, the Juneau-Douglas City Museum, the Dimond Courthouse, the hostel or other locations at the top of the hill," Capital Transit's Denise Guizio said.

There are four bus stops in the Ride Free Zone – the Marine Parking Garage, on Franklin Street near the old Gunakadeit Park (Pocket Park), on Fourth Street near Rainbow Foods and the Downtown Transit Center.
