JOINT MOTION FOR THIRTY DAY STAY OF ALL PRETRIAL DEADLINES

Plaintiffs Cruise Lines International Association Alaska, and Cruise Lines International Association (“Plaintiffs”) and Defendants City and Borough of Juneau, Alaska and Rorie Watt (“Defendants”) (collectively, the “Parties”), for the reasons below, jointly request a stay of all pretrial deadlines for thirty (30) days.

1. Plaintiffs filed their Complaint (ECF No. 1) on April 13, 2016. On May 18, 2016, Plaintiffs filed their First Amended Complaint (ECF No. 16-1) (“FAC”), which was entered on the docket on August 10, 2016 (ECF No. 28).

2. Defendants answered the FAC on October 28, 2016 (ECF No. 40).

3. On December 23, 2016, the Court entered its Scheduling and Planning Order (ECF No. 46) (the “Scheduling Order”).

4. On January 25, 2017, the Court entered an Amended Scheduling Order (ECF No. 48), based on a stipulation submitted to the Court (ECF No. 47) by the Parties to modify the Court’s then-governing scheduling and planning order.

5. Since that time, the Parties have commenced settlement efforts. The Parties’ settlement efforts are continuing, and the Parties believe that additional time may allow them to resolve this case without further litigation.

6. Because the Parties are actively engaged in settlement efforts and because increasing litigation costs, including attorney’s fees, diminish the likelihood of successful settlement, the Parties jointly request that the Court stay all pretrial deadlines for thirty (30) days, until and through April 14, 2017.

7. Should the Court grant the Parties’ joint motion to stay all pretrial deadlines for thirty (30) days, until and through April 14, 2017, the Parties will provide the Court a joint status report outlining the status of settlement efforts on or before April 12, 2017.
