***Assemblymember Jonathan Anderson Resigns
Assembly Seeking Interested Persons Willing to Complete Term***

Jonathan Anderson announced his resignation as CBJ Assemblymember, District 2, to be effective following the May 23, 2011 Assembly meeting. Mr. Anderson was elected to his first term in 2005 and re-elected in 2008 to his current term, which ends in October, 2011. He and his wife Mary will be relocating from Juneau to San Bernadino, California, where he will assume a position as Chair of the Public Administration Department at California State University.

City Charter and Code outline the procedure for filling a vacancy on the Assembly. The Assembly will elect by majority vote of the remaining members a qualified resident of the election district from which the vacancy arose to be the acting Assemblymember until the next regular election.

The Assembly is soliciting letters of interest, along with resumes, from qualified citizens, and has set a deadline of April 7, at 4:30 p.m., in the Municipal Clerk's Office, for receipt of those letters. The Assembly will consider the applications in executive session at its April 11, 2011 regular meeting.

To be qualified for this office, an applicant must be a qualified voter of the municipality, who has been a resident of the municipality for at least one year immediately preceding appointment to office.

In addition, the applicant shall be a resident of the district from which appointed at the time of appointment. Mr. Anderson serves in the District 2 seat, which includes the following municipal precincts: Mendenhall Valley #1, #2, #3, #4, Auke Bay/Fritz Cove and Lynn Canal.

A Public Official Financial Disclosure Statement must be filed upon appointment to office.
