Session 1 – Tuesday, May 2nd 6:00pm-9:00pm (3hr) Potential disasters in our local community, Individual and family emergency preparedness, and "how to" information on non-structural hazard mitigation. The Incident Command System (ICS) teamwork, organization, and planning. **Hagevig FTC**

Session 2 – Saturday, May 6th 9:00am-1:00pm (4hr) Disaster medical operations, triage, transportation, treatment area management, **Bartlett Regional – Administrative Building – Conference Room**

Session 3 – Tuesday, May 9th 6:00p.m. -9:00p.m. Light search and rescue operations, limitations, safety concerns, techniques, evacuation, mechanical advantage and basic cribbing. **Hagevig FTC**

Session 4- Saturday, May 13th 9:00a.m-1:00p.m. Head-to-toe patient evaluation with recognition and treatment of both life threatening and non-life-threatening injuries. **Location TBD**

Session 5-Tuesday, May 16th, 6:00p.m.9:00p.m. Terrorism, our risks, impacts, best responses to a terrorist incident. **Hagevig FTC**

Session 6 – Saturday, May 20th 9:00a.m - 1:00p.m. Basic fire suppression techniques. Best practices, fire extinguisher types and usage. Participants will extinguish a fire and begin to develop self-confidence and teamwork. **Hagevig FTC**

Session 7- Tuesday May 23rd, 6:00p.m.-9:00p.m. Disaster psych The emotional environment and psychology of a disaster. Course Review, question and answer to everything previously covered. Instructions and overview of the rodeo. **Hagevig FTC**

Session 8 – Saturday, May 27th 9:00am-1:00pm (4hr) Course review, test and simulated **Disaster Exercise**. Participants will apply the principles they have learned in a simulated disaster. This exercise will dramatize the multi-functional training approach, as well as promote team reliance. **Hagevig FTC**
