### **Glacier Avenue pavement work begins May 22**

*Public should anticipate disruptions in traffic and Capital Transit bus service*



Starting Monday evening, May 22, contractors for the City and Borough of Juneau will be doing pavement work on Glacier Avenue between West 12th Street and the Gold Creek Bridge, extending slightly into West Willoughby Avenue. The work will impact traffic and may cause excessive noise during the evening hours.

SECON will be removing the top section of pavement and repaving the roadway from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. Weather depending, the work is scheduled to be complete by Friday, May 26. During this time frame, the public can anticipate some traffic revisions. Please follow traffic control signage and flaggers, and drive cautiously.

Capital Transit evening service will also be disrupted each day of pavement work after 5 p.m. Informational signs will be posted at all affected bus stops. There will be no bus service at the Federal Building or Foodland IGA bus stops, including no transfers at the Federal Building. The bus stop at the Alaska State Museum will offer service to the Mendenhall Valley, but not to Downtown. The bus stop at West 12th Street will offer service to Downtown, but not to the Mendenhall Valley. All transfers will be made at the Downtown Transit Center.
