Delta service returns to Juneau Airport

With increased airport activity, travelers should allow more time to check in

Delta Air Lines starts seasonal service into Juneau International Airport May 19. Delta is operating a Boeing 737 aircraft and has one flight a day between Juneau and Seattle, arriving in Juneau at night and departing early in the morning.

Airport Manager Patty Wahto said Delta now has approved specialized approaches (RNP) into Juneau.

“When the weather is kind of nasty, instead of doing missed approaches, Delta has a better chance of getting in. It’s similar to what Alaska Airlines has. It puts Delta at a level playing field as far as getting in and out,” Wahto said.

With Delta’s return to Juneau and general increased seasonal activity at the airport, travelers should allow two hours to check in, including baggage and getting through the passenger screening checkpoint.

“It’s a busy time of year,” Wahto said, “We’re seeing more passengers moving through Juneau Airport. Plan accordingly and follow the 2-hour rule.”
