Wed June 21—Treadwell Gold Presentation, Douglas Library @ 7:00pm

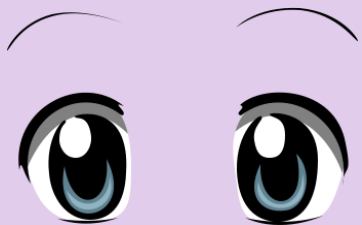
