- '92-'93 ***China Joe* by Brett Dillingham.** Live performance videotaped.
- Crime and Punishment: A history of Criminal Justice in Alaska's Capital City* by Teleferio Hall.** Stories from 1891-1984 documenting crimes in Juneau. Booklet with photographs.
- We Taught in Juneau* by Juneau Retired Teachers Association, Juneau Alaska.** Biographies of teachers in Juneau from the 1930s to 1950s, with an overview of Juneau Schools before Statehood. Booklet with photographs.
- '93-'94 ***Growing Up in Juneau* Edited by Laury Roberts Scandling, written in the Marie Drake Middle School Language Arts Challenge Program.** Cross-cultural interviews and biographies of 25 men and women who grew up in Juneau written by middle school students. Booklet with photos.
- Vital Records from Alaska Daily Empire 1916-1920, Juneau, Alaska* by Betty J. Miller.** Records from the Alaska Daily Empire on marriages, divorces, deaths, births, adoptions, christenings and anniversaries. Booklet, no photos.
- '94-'95 ***Artists in Juneau 1880-1960* by Kenneth DeRoux.** An index of artists, resident and visiting, who worked in the Juneau area during the city's first eighty years. Booklet with photos.
