Schedule For Firefighter/EMT & Firefighter/Paramedic Testing

The schedule presented here is tentative and may be changed at any time due to the number of candidates. Candidates will be informed with any changes as soon as possible and will be posted at all testing sites.

August 6, 2017 (Location: Hagevig Regional Fire Training Center (Clean Classroom), 2610 Sherwood Lane)

0800 – 0900	Introduction & Paperwork Walk-Through of the Physical Ability Test Issuing gear as needed
0900 – 1500	Physical Ability Test Will start with walk-through of test You will be notified on site if you pass or fail Open lunch will be provided Must pass to continue in process
1200-1300	Paramedic Static EKG Examination
1300-1800	Practical EMS Examinations

Candidates proceeding to the following day of testing will be given a schedule of when they are assigned times for their Interview Panel, Oral Board Panel (Paramedic Candidates Only) and Fire Chief Interview.

August 7, 2017 (Location: Station 1, 820 Glacier Avenue) - Lunch Provided for Panel Members

0900-1800	Interview Panel (Times will be assigned and posted at the testing site on the previous day)
0800-1030	Oral Board Panel (Paramedic Candidates Only)
1030-1800	Fire Chief Interview

Results will be tallied and posted in the form of a ranked, eligibility list. Conditional job offers will be made as positions become available to the eligible candidate utilizing the eligibility list. Candidates will be notified of their ranking on the eligibility list within three working days after the completion of testing.

Continuance:

Scores from testing will be utilized to create an eligibility list for hiring for Capital City Fire/Rescue. This list will be valid for one year or another testing has concluded, whichever comes first. The Fire Chief at any time can retire the current eligibility list. Conditional job offers will be made to candidates to fill vacancies. Once a candidate has been given a conditional job offer, they will need to successfully complete a psychological and medical examination, both will be scheduled with the candidate. Written psychological examinations will be provided on **August 8, 2017** at Capital City Fire/Rescue's classroom at Station 1 at 0830 hours to individuals that conditional job offers have been made to.
