SENIOR GROOMER

PERMANENT FULL-TIME POSITION

This is a fully benefited position. The City and Borough of Juneau offers a competitive salary package that includes the opportunity for regular salary increases, an excellent health insurance program, paid leave, and retirement credit through PERS (Public Employees' Retirement System).

RESPONSIBILITIES

Under general supervision of the Director of Mountain Operations, performs a combination of job functions. Winter responsibilities include assisting in the development and completion of the nightly mountain grooming requirements. The position motivates and supervises other shift groomers, makes suggestions to maximize grooming resources, make routes more efficient and reduce fuel consumption. The position requires skiing or snowboarding several times weekly to check the quality of the grooming product.

Summer responsibilities include assisting in the maintenance of all Eaglecrest equipment including snowcats, snowmaking equipment, generators, snowmachines, and various small equipment. Will help perform summer maintenance and repairs to chairlifts and associated ski lift drive equipment. Will perform minor building and grounds maintenance, as well as learn the operation of the water treatment system. Safe and effective operation of all equipment is expected.

Typical responsibilities include the following:

- Evaluates the prevailing snow conditions and makes decisions as to what grooming techniques and machines will be needed to achieve a smooth skiing surface that is free of bumps, ruts, icy spots, drifts. And other unsafe or undesirable surface conditions.
- Monitors the quality of the snow produced; makes adjustments to snowmaking equipment as necessary.
- Trains other staff in the safe and efficient operation of grooming equipment such as tractors, backhoes, bulldozers, snowgroomers, compressors, pumps and all other equipment related to grooming/snowmaking operations.
- Maintains accurate grooming reports.
- Receives nightly grooming directives from the Director of Mountain Operations or the Director of Snow Safety.
- Supervises and trains other shift groomers in the proper snow surface preparation to achieve a safe, quality, and enjoyable ski experience for customers.
- Performs maintenance of all Eaglecrest equipment including snowcats, snowmaking equipment, generators, snowmachines, and various small equipment.
- Assists in summer maintenance and repairs to chairlifts and associated ski lift drive equipment.
- Performs minor building and grounds maintenance.
- Learns the operation of the water treatment system.
- Performs other duties as assigned from time to time.
- Other related duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Experience: Two (2) seasons of experience in the operation of snowmaking and grooming equipment.

Substitution: Any equivalent combination of education and experience.

Licenses: A valid State of Alaska driver's license **at time of appointment and for continued employment.**

Note: Those with previous experience in maintaining heavy equipment, welding, or fabrication are encouraged to apply.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Must be able to climb and have no fear of working in high places. Must have good guest service skills; be able to work a schedule which includes long hours, weekends and holidays; and be able to function well in adverse weather conditions.
