RESPONSIBILITIES

The incumbent is responsible for assisting the trail maintenance crew in conducting summer projects that include ski, hike, and mountain bike trail maintenance and construction at Eaglecrest. Incumbents work under direct supervision of the Trails Manager and with detailed guidelines for small crew missions.

Typical responsibilities include the following:

- Brushing and tree clearing work.
- Using power brushers, chain saws, hand tools and power tools.
- Pushing, pulling, digging, drilling and lifting heavy objects.
- Hiking into and out of work project sites over mountainous terrain in varying weather.
- Assisting with minor mechanical and maintenance work.
- Adhere to work safety practices.
- Operating an ATV and tracked hauler.
- Assisting with accurate record-keeping on all work performed.
- Other related duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Experience: Must be at least 18 years of age **at time of appointment.**
Previous lift operator experience is preferred but not required.
Ability to operate front-end loader is preferred but not required.
Some carpentry experience is preferred but not required.

Other: Must possess a valid Alaska Driver's license **at time of appointment and for continued employment.**
