Subject: Assault 3rd Degree

Summary:

On June 8, 2009 at about 0105 hours, the Juneau Police Department received a report of a disturbance occurring in the 400 block of 7th Street in Downtown Juneau. The complainant reported they could hear two (2) men and woman arguing and shouting for about 15 to 20 minutes.

Officers responded to the area and found a 41 year old Juneau man with a laceration to his neck. Capital City Fire and Rescue responded to the scene and transported the man to Bartlett Regional Hospital for treatment of a laceration to the neck.

Investigation revealed that the 41 year old man and his 43 year old girlfriend were visiting 60 year old Juneau resident, Freeman MANN. An altercation broke out between the victim and MANN. During the altercation MANN cut the victim in the neck with a knife. MANN was placed under arrest for Assault in the 3rd Degree, a Class C Felony and taken to the Lemon Creek Correctional Center. MANN was held without bail.

Any charges reported in this press release are merely accusations and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
