a. Bill Leedy made a presentation to the Commission regarding HB 152 approved by the Alaska legislature, authorizing \$100M in support of alternative energy exploration.

The Bill created the possibility of a joint effort by the CBJ and AEL&P toward a "proof of concept" and the creation of a demonstration plant for "Solid State Ammonia Synthesis." The concept would require a budget of some \$7-800K and would produce Anhydrous Ammonia (NA 3) for a variety of uses. The deadline for a proposal is 30 September and does not offer much time to work out the details. Regardless, the idea should be retained for future use.
